RESOLUTION Nº 74, NOVEMBER 06, 2009.

THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF THE FOREIGN TRADE CHAMBER, according to the discussion held at the meeting that took place on October 28th, 2009, based on items I, II, XIV, and § 2º of the article 2º of the Decree nº 4732 of June 10, 2003

DECIDES

Article 1 – To establish the procedures for a public consultation on the Preliminary List ("List") of Mercosur Common Nomenclature (NCM) Codes, which may be subject to the application of countermeasures resulting from the United States failure to comply with the decisions and recommendations adopted by the Dispute Settlement Board of the World Trade Organization (WTO) in the context of litigation "The United States of America – Subsidies on Upland Cotton "(WT / DS 267).

Article 2 - The documentation regarding the public consultation may be found on this Resolution's annexes I to V.

Article 3 - The countermeasures this consultation refers to will consist on the imposition of an additional import duty of up to 100 percentage points applied on products selected by CAMEX, originating and coming from the United States of America, and does not exclude the adoption of other countermeasures or the inclusion of other tariff codes, based on CAMEX's decision.

Article 4 - This resolution enters into force on the date of its publication.

ANNEX I - BACKGROUND

1. Through a dispute settlement procedure, a WTO Panel and Appellate Body considered certain measures adopted by the United States to be incompatible to Articles 3.1 (a), 3.2, 6.3 (c) and 5 (c) of the WTO's Agreement on Subsidies and Countervailing Measures (ASMC), and to the Articles 10.1 and 8 of the WTO Agreement on Agriculture. In the March 21st, 2005, the Dispute Settlement Board adopted the report of the Appellate Body (WT/DS267/AB/R) and the report of the Panel (WT/DS267/R and Corr.1), as modified by the report of the Appellate Body. The Dispute Settlement Body's recommendations and decisions resulting of the procedures mentioned above included the following recommendations to the United States of America: elimination of the adverse effects of certain subsidies or elimination of the subsidies within six months from the adoption of the reports; compliance with the Agreement on Agriculture; and prompt elimination of the non-complying subsidies.

2. The procedure for Dispute Settlement was held under the Understanding on Rules and Procedures of the WTO Settlement Solutions ("Understanding"), Annex 2 of the WTO Constitutive Agreement, according to Annex 2 of the Final Act of the Uruguay Round of Multilateral Trade Negotiations of the General Agreement Tariffs and Trade - GATT, approved by Legislative Decree 30 of December 15, 1994, and implemented by Decree 1355 of December 30, 1994.

3. The deadlines for compliance with the Dispute Settlement Bodies' recommendations expired on July 1st and September 21th, 2005. On July 4th and October 6th, 2005, Brazil requested authorization of the Dispute Resolution to adopt countermeasures under the Article 4.10 and 7.9 of the ASCM and of the Article 22.2 of Understanding (WT/DS267/21 and WT/DS267/26).

4. On July 14th and October 17th, 2005, the U.S. objected to the Brazilian requests (WT/DS267/23 and WT/DS267/27) and the matter was referred to arbitration under the Article 22.6 of Understanding and the Articles 4.11 and 7.10 of ASMC. On August 18th and December 7th, 2005, the arbitration proceedings were suspended (WT/DS267/25 and WT/DS267/29).

5. On August 18th, 2006, Brazil requested the establishment of an Implementation Panel under the Article 21.5 of the Understanding. On December 18th, 2007, the Panel report was sent to WTO members (WT/DS267/RW). The Implementation Panel deemed that the U.S. had not complied with the recommendations of the Dispute Settlement Body and continued to act in a manner incompatible with the Articles 3.1 (a), 3.2, 6.3 (c) and 5 (c) of the ASCM, and Articles 10.1 and 8 of the Agreement on Agriculture of the WTO. The report of the Appellate Body, circulated on June 2nd, 2008, confirmed the findings of the Implementation Panel (WT/DS267/ABR). On June, 20th, 2008, the WTO Dispute Settlement Body adopted the report of the Appellate Body and the report of the Implementation Panel, as modified by the report of the Appellate Body.

6. On August 25th, 2008, Brazil requested the resumption of arbitration proceedings (WT/DS267/38 and WT/DS267/39). On August 31, 2009, the Arbitrator issued its decisions (WT/DS267/ARB/1 and WT/DS267/ARB/2) about the countermeasures which Brazil is entitled.

ANNEX II - PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC CONSULTATION

1. In order to assist with eventual revisions of the list, the interested parties, preferably through associations or professional associations, shall deliver, until Monday, 11/30/2009, comments according to the Guide for Comments (Annex IV - "guide").

2. The printed comments should be directed to the Executive Secretary of the Foreign Trade Chamber via the General Receiving Office of the Ministry of Development, Industry and Foreign Trade, located at the Esplanada dos Ministerios, Bloco "J", Ground Floor, CEP 70053-900, Brasília (DF), and electronically, via e-mail: contenciosoalgodao@mdic.gov.br. Comments submitted exclusively by email will not be considered. It is necessary to file the original printed and signed forms with the General Receiving Office.

3. For purposes of standardization, the file names of electronic submissions should follow the following pattern: the letters "NCM", the symbol "_", the product code NCM with eight digits with dots, the symbol "_", the name of the party submitting the comments or its acronym. Only files with extension ".doc" will be accepted.

4. The petitions must observe the specified format detailed on the Annex IV (Guide for Petitions). There will be no telephone or any other service through which the contents of this Decree will be discussed. It is recommended that the attached explanatory notes (Annex V -- "Notes") be read carefully.

5. Each completed guide (submission) should refer to a single tariff item.

A - EXPLANATORY NOTES FOR THE CAMEX RESOLUTION

- Note pertaining to article 3: the imposition of additional duties up to 100 percentage points on U.S. imports means that a product with an original importation tariff of 12%, for example, would then rise 112%, as a result of the countermeasures applied.

B - NOTES PERTAINING TO ANNEX II - PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC CONSULTATION

- Note pertaining to paragraph 2: for the purposes of information security, every petition must be submitted in two ways: one hardcopy (signed original document) and one electronic (e-mail). The lack of either will result in the withdrawal of the corresponding petition.
- Note pertaining to paragraph 3: the (petition) file related to NCM code 2716.00.00 from the "Representative Association X" should be saved as: NCM_2716.00.00_RepresentativeAssociationX.doc
- Note pertaining to paragraph 5: Each petition must refer to a single NCM code, though it can cite more than one specific product classified under the same NCM code. It is possible to submit as many petitions as possible, so long as each submission corresponds to a different NCM code.

C - NOTES PERTAINING TO ANNEX IV - PETITION GUIDE

- Note pertaining to the field "NCM code object of this petition" should be filled with the NCM Code as shown in the "Preliminary List" of this resolution.
- Note pertaining to the field "2.1) A succinct description of the specific product that led to the submission this petition" must specify the product or the specific products -- classified under the same NCM Code. That is, it should refer to the product or products related to the item that is produced, imported, exported, distributed, etc., in accordance to the field "1.6) Activity of the petitioner" from the Petition Guide.
- Note pertaining to the field "1.6) Activity of the petitioner (producer, importer, exporter, distributor, etc.)": the petitioner should disclose the type of activity related to the product(s) indicated in the submission.
- Note pertaining to the field "2.5) Potential impact of the measure": should be filled with a concise record of the economic and/or commercial impact that the petitioner might face as a result of the higher tariff rates levied against the specified product of the petition. In particular, specific issues concerning possible expectations with respect to supply problems, the existence or inexistence of alternative suppliers (outside of the U.S.) of the specific product, as well as expectations of rising prices of the finished goods for which the product in question is an element. If the petitioner deems necessary, relevant data specifying the production and commercial attributes of the corresponding product can be added.
