Promote easing U.S. export control measures for military and dual-use products, services and technologies being exported to Brazil.



Support the Brazilian National Congress's approval of PDC 424/2016, Air Transport Agreement (ASA or Open Skies).



Applaud the Brazilian and U.S. governments for committing to advancing the Aviation Partnership and its effort to align private sector expertise with investment opportunities.
